Operation Encompass

Ladywood School is in partnership with Bolton Safeguarding Board and Greater Manchester Police in a project called "Bolton Encompass". The project is designed to provide support for children who may be impacted on by domestic violence. Information from Encompass will be shared with Mrs Susan Tailor who has been identified as key adult at Ladywood. The key adult will ensure that appropriate supportive strategies are put in place.



Dinner Money

The cost for dinner money is £2.20/day, £11.00/week. Should you wish your child to change from sandwiches to school meals or vice versa please can you give the school office notice. This can be paid cash or by SIMS pay.

Dinner money can also be paid for the half term or for the term.

Allergen Aware
